

ORDINANCE NO. 21-47

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE COMPENSATION OF THE VILLAGE ZONING OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of DeGraff (the "Village") currently employs a Zoning Officer at the rate of \$3,800.04 per year;

WHEREAS, the Village, upon consultation and recommendation of the Mayor and based upon the performance of the Zoning Officer, seeks to increase the compensation of the Zoning Officer by 2.5%, or \$95.00 x 2.5%, for a total salary of \$3,895.04 per year, effective beginning January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Village believes the Zoning Officer should be paid in the same manner and from the same funds as the Zoning Officer was previously paid, and all other benefits previously payable to the Zoning Officer and not modified herein shall remain payable to the Zoning Officer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO:

SECTION I: Salary of the Zoning Officer shall increase to \$3,895.04 per year, effective January 1, 2022. The Zoning Officer shall be paid in the same manner and from the same funds as the Zoning Officer was previously paid. All other benefits previously payable to the Zoning Officer unchanged by this Ordinance shall continue to remain payable to the Zoning Officer.

SECTION II: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Village of DeGraff, Ohio, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services, and to allow for the modification of the salary of the Village Zoning Officer at the earliest possible time, and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
