

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-20

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO CONTRACT WITH GARMANN MILLER FOR A FEASIBILITY STUDY OF THE EXISTING FIRE STATION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the Mayor and/or Village Administrator be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into contract with Garmann Miller, 38 S. Lincoln Dr., Minster, OH 45865, for the purpose of Garmann Miller performing a Feasibility Study of the existing fire station within the Village of DeGraff, Ohio, for a cost not to exceed \$15,500.00 as outlined in the Proposal Letter and AIA contract B104 and Terms and Conditions attached hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A.

SECTION II: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of said Village, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services, to enter into contract; and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
