ORDINANCE NO. 2023-37

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the Mayor and Village Administrator be, and they hereby are, authorized to apply for and accept a Safety Intervention Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation in the sum of \$40,000.00, with the Village's contribution being \$24,650.00 for the purchase of 1 Horizon SQ3TS Portable Traffic Signal and Wireless Remote Package, totaling \$64,650.00.

SECTION II: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the Village of DeGraff, provided for its continuous uninterrupted services, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services, and to allow for said contract to be entered into at the earliest possible time; and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
