

ORDINANCE NO. 2026-12

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO DEPOSIT FUNDS FROM THE SALE OF THE POLICE CRUISER INTO THE OTHER SPECIAL REVENUE FUND AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the Village of DeGraff previously enacted Ordinance No. 2026-12, which permitted the sale of the Village's Police Cruiser on Govdeals.

WHEREAS, the Police Cruiser sold at auction for \$18,000.

WHEREAS, the Village now seeks to clarify what line item / fund said sale proceeds should be deposited for further future use by the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO:

SECTION I: That any funds from the sale of the Village's Police Cruiser shall be deposited into the Other Special Revenue Fund.

SECTION III: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of said City, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services; and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
