ORDINANCE # 2025-15

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE DISCARDING OF MUNICIPAL PERSONAL PROPERTY THAT IS NOT NEEDED FOR PUBLIC USE, IS OBSOLETE AND UNFIT FOR THE USE FOR WHICH IT WAS ACQUIRED, AND HAS NO VALUE IN ACCORDANCE WITH R.C. § 721.15(C) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY IN THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO

WHEREAS, the Village of DeGraff, Ohio is the owns certain firefighter turnout gear (the "Turnout Gear"), more specifically identified in the attached and incorporated Exhibit A, which is more than ten (10) years old;

WHEREAS, the Turnout Gear is not needed for public use, is obsolete and unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and has no value;

WHEREAS, the Village of DeGraff seeks to donate said Turnout Gear to Overseas/Walter Cook in accordance and compliance with the requirements of R.C. § 721.15(C);

WHEREAS, the Village of DeGraff has a reasonable and good faith belief that the Turnout Gear is not needed for public use, is obsolete and unfit for the use for which it was acquired, and has no value;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF DEGRAFF, OHIO:

SECTION I: That the Village Administrator be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to donate the Turnout Gear to Overseas/Walter Cook.

SECTION II: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure made necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of said Village, provide for its continuous uninterrupted services, and to allow for said easement to be executed at the earliest possible time; and it shall, therefore, be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage and signature by the Mayor.
